# RULES AND INFORMATION

**ALL DECISIONS MADE BY THE ARENA DIRECTORS AND FLAGGERS WILL BE FINAL!!!**

**ANY TIME A PARENT IS LEADING, WALKING OR RUNNING WITH CONTESTANT A 10-SECOND PENALTY WILL BE ADDED TO TIME. ONLY EXCEPTION IS IN RUN-RIDE-LEAD AND PARENT CAN HELP CHILD ON AND OFF HORSE.**

**ALL ROUGH STOCK RIDING EVENTS WILL HAVE 1 OR 2 GOES DEPENDING ON NUMBER OF ENTRIES.**

**SHEEP RIDING:** Must ride for 6 seconds. If rider falls off before whistle is blown rider will be ruled a **NO SCORE**.

**CALF/COW/STEER RIDING:** 1 or 2 hands. Must ride for 6 seconds. If rider bucks off before whistle is blown then rider will be ruled a **NO SCORE**. Rider will score higher if 1 hand is used and calf is spurred.

**BARREL/POLE RACING:** High School Rodeo rules.

**TEAM/BREAKAWAY ROPING:** High School Rodeo rules, **except** no barrier. If steer is caught before barrel a 10-second penalty will be added to time.

**GOAT TYING:** High School Rodeo rules.

**CALF TYING:** Same as goat tying rules **except** use piggin string.

**GOAT UNTYING:** Must ride horse to goat, get off and time will stop as soon as ribbon (any or all) is taken from tail.

**STEER DAUBING:** Timed event. Time stops when steer is daubed by bat and contestant raises bat in air.

**Flagger's decision is final.**

**KEY HOLE RACE:** 1 foot of horse on or outside of the designated line will be ruled a 5 second penalty. More than 1 foot of horse outside of line will be ruled a **NO TIME**.

**RUN-RIDE-LEAD:** **No** halters or lead ropes. Must use reins. Please note: **HORSE MUST BE RIDDEN COMPLETELY ACROSS THE LINE AND HAVE ALL 4 FEET ACROSS OR JUDGE WILL RULE A 5-SECOND PENALTY.**

**PAYOFF AND PRIZES:** **Money paid on the average** of times not go rounds. 4 places paid for both boys & girls.

All events will pay the same for 1st thru 4th places. **Points toward all around are given on each go.**

Points given to 1st thru 6th places for both boys & girls in each age group. All around prizes to 6th place.

**QUEEN CONTEST:** Practice riding your horse, be prepared to give a short speech, and have fun!
